Reservations at our group rate may be accepted until **Tuesday, March 31, 2020**, based on room and rate availability.

Our preferred group rate is **\$189 per night for a Classic guest room**, single or double occupancy, subject to applicable taxes and fees (currently 2% Destination Marketing Levy and 15% HST, subject to change).

Guest rooms include complimentary wireless internet access. There is no charge for local phone calls, 1-800 and calling card access.

For registered guests, underground self-parking is \$28 and valet parking is \$40; rates are per night, plus tax.

The Arms Restaurant is located just off the lobby. It is open daily for breakfast, lunch and dinner and features traditional English pub fare, as well as a variety of tempting international dishes. Reservations at our group rate may be accepted until **Wednesday, April 15, 2020**, based on room and rate availability.

Our preferred group rate is **\$109 per night for a two-bedroom suite with one single bed per room**, single or double occupancy, subject to applicable taxes and fees (currently 2% Destination Marketing Levy and 15% HST, subject to change). Two-night minimum stay required.

Suites include two private bedrooms with one single bed per room, one washroom, small sitting area and kitchenette. Rate includes linen, towels, wireless internet access, daily membership pass to the Delpex fitness facility, and on-campus overnight parking (subject to availability, one permit per room per night).

All-you-care-to-eat meal service is available in the Howe Hall dining hall; payable in cash at the door:

- Breakfast 0700-1000: \$9 per person plus taxes
- Lunch 1100-1400: \$10.60 per person plus taxes
- Dinner 1700-1900: \$14.85 per person plus taxes

Individuals are responsible for paying for their own accommodations **upon check-in**.

Cancellation or changes must be received by 3:00 p.m. local time on the day prior to the scheduled arrival date or charges for room and tax for the first night of the reservation will be paid by the individual.

Check-in begins at 3:00 p.m.; check-out time is 10:30 a.m. Luggage storage arrangements can be made at the facility's front desk.
